2011 SCULPTURE AWARD

The Irish Concrete Society is pleased to continue a special Award scheme for sculpture, in which the Society wishes to make an Award for excellence in the design/construction of a sculptural project.

In addition, the Society is sponsoring a cash prize of €1,000 to the winning sculptor.

This Award scheme enables the Society to acknowledge the work of sculptors who use concrete as a medium of expression. Entries are eligible which use concrete as the main visual element in the sculpture.

The adjudication will be carried out by an independent jury convened by the Council of the Society.

Nominations for the award may be made by sculptors or others directly involved in the nomination. Nominations must refer to work **completed since August 1st 2009** which is currently in Ireland and which can be made available for inspection by the jury later in the year, if requested.

All entries will be displayed at an Awards Evening held in early 2012, at which the winner will be announced.
