

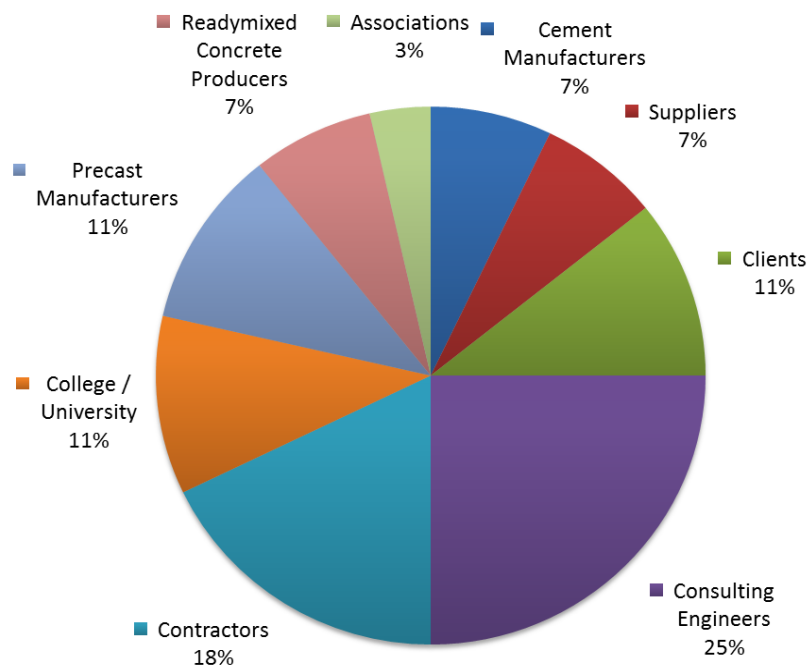


## Irish Concrete Society
