IRISH CONCRETE SOCIETY

The Irish Concrete Society will again make an award for excellence in the design or construction of a completed **building, structure or concrete element**, irrespective of type, scale or complexity, in concrete. This scheme is now well established and attracts a wide range of entries from both small and large projects alike.

The award scheme is organised to enable the Society acknowledge construction achievements in which **concrete in any form** contributes significantly to the built environment. Entries relating to the contribution made by concrete to any aspect of building, civil engineering, architecture, art or landscaping will be accepted by the Society.

**Entries are sub divided into three categories:**

- **Building**
- **Infrastructural**
- **Elemental (Housing or small projects, e.g. walls, stairs, paving)**

**There will be one overall winner chosen, with category winners in the other sections, depending on the level and quality of entries.**

**The jury will also consider awarding special recognition for the use of concrete in a sustainable context. Nominations should include a brief description of the contribution of concrete in this regard.**

The adjudication will be carried out by an independent jury convened by the Council of the Society.

Nominations for the Award may be made by Clients, Architects, Consulting Engineers, Materials Suppliers, Contractors or others directly involved with the nomination. Nominations must refer to **completed work, located in Ireland, which commenced after January 2008.**

Note: Entries submitted for the previous year's Award remain eligible for this year's scheme if they meet the above completion date. However, a new nomination form and photographs must be re-submitted.

**Entries will be selected by the jury for display at the Awards Evening. Photographs must be of high quality and submitted in digital format (jpeg only) on a compact disk.**
