## About

The Concrete Ticket is an on-demand course developed by a panel of academic and industry experts and is administered by the Irish Concrete Society.

The course provides participants with essential information on concrete materials and properties, including requirements for ordering and delivery ready-mixed concrete.

## Content

**Part 1** - Materials, Properties and Reinforcement.

**Part 2** - Ordering, Production, Delivery and Formwork.

**Part 3** - Placing, Compacting and Finishing.

**Part 4** - Curing, Protection and Joints.



## Each part is followed by a multiple choice question test.

## Who should attend?

This course has been specifically designed and developed for construction workers responsible for **receiving, transporting, placing and finishing** concrete after its arrival on site.

The course will also benefit anyone involved in the **manufacture, dispatch or transport** of ready mixed concrete, and those in **precast** production.

Early career stage engineers would also benefit from the course.

## Duration

The course takes approximately two hours to complete. The course can be accessed online at any time and is designed to be completed in your own time.
