2026 Concrete Sculpture Award Rules of Entry

The Irish Concrete Society presents a special Award scheme for sculptures which use concrete as a medium of expression. Entries should use concrete as the main visual element in the work.

The winning artist(s) will receive a prize totalling €1,000.

To be eligible for entry to the competition, the work must be:

1. An original piece of work by the artist(s).
2. Located in Ireland (either publicly or privately).
3. Completed after the 31st of July 2024.
4. Made available to be viewed by the jury, if required.

The jury shall be appointed by the Council of the Society. The discretion of the jury is absolute, and all jury decisions are final. No discussion or correspondence relating to any decisions will be entered into by the jury or the Irish Concrete Society.

Note: entries must include a description of the work, method of construction, reason for the nomination and 6 high quality digital photographs* (150 dpi, jpg). Any entry omitting these may not be accepted by the jury.

*Photographs will help the jury form initial impressions on the merits of the entry, be displayed at the Awards Evening, and may be retained for use in future communications.
